Prince Albert Municipality hereby invites tenders for the **CONSTRUCTION OF NEW HIGH MAST LIGHTS AND SOLAR PV WITHIN THE PRINCE ALBERT MUNICIPAL AREAS FOR THE PRINCE ALBERT MUNICIPALITY.** The scope of this project is for the supply, delivery and installation of 30-meter-high mast lights; 20 m Scissor-masts, Supply and installation of Solar PV systems at various Municipal facilities for Prince Albert Municipality.

Tender Documents will not be available electronically. Hard copy tender documents will only be available at the Consulting Engineer (Neil Lyners and Associates (PTY) Ltd) offices at Building 8, Fairview Office Park, 1st Street, George, 6529 during office hours (Monday-Thursday, 08h00 to 16h00, and Friday, 08h00 to 15h30).

Bidders are required to be registered at the Construction Industry Development Board (CIDB). Only those tenderers who are registered with the CIDB, in a contractor grading designation equal to or higher than a contractor grading designation determined in accordance with the sum tendered, or a value determined in accordance with Regulation 25 (1B) or 25 (7A) of the Construction Industry Development Regulations for a 5 EP or Higher class of construction work are eligible to have their tenders evaluated.

There will be no tender clarification meeting and tenderers must familiarise themselves with conditions on site at their own accord. This bid is also not subject to functionality scoring.

Bids must remain valid for a period of twelve (12) weeks after the closing date of the bid. Enquiries can be directed as follow:

Bids must be submitted in sealed envelopes, clearly marked with the **TENDER NUMBER** <u>AND</u> **TENDER DESCRIPTION**. Bidders that fail to adhere to this requirement, will be disqualified at the bid opening. Bids must be deposited in the tender box at the Prince Albert Municipality's Finance Division (Thusong Centre, Adderley

Street, Prince Albert, 6930). The tender box will be open for depositing as follows:

- Monday to Thursday: 07h30 and 16h00
- Fridays: 07h30 and 15h30.

Bids will be opened in immediately after the closing date at the Finance Division Boardroom (Finance Building, Thusong Centre). Late or unmarked bids will not be considered. **Telegraphic, telephonic, telex, facsimile, e-mail and late bids will not be accepted.**

Bids will be evaluated according to the 80/20 preference points system. The bids are subject to the latest Council's Supply Chain Management Policy, the Municipal Preferential Procurement Policy, and the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2022 (Government Gazette 47452, dated 04/11/2022). **Tenderers must be registered on the Central Supplier Database (CSD) if they wish to conduct business with the municipality.**

The preferential points system applied (80/20) in terms of the Preferential Procurement Policy are as follow:

The Municipality reserves the right to withdraw any invitation to bid and/or re-advertise or to reject any bid or to accept a part of it. The Municipality does not bind itself to accept the lowest bid or to award a contract to the Bidder scoring the highest number of points.

NO BIDS WILL BE CONSIDERED FROM PERSONS IN THE SERVICE OF THE STATE AS DEFINED IN THE MUNICIPAL SUPPLY CHAIN MANAGEMENT REGULATIONS.
