



PEACE AND SAFETY WARDEN PROGRAMME

The Western Cape Government through the Department of Community Safety adopted the Peace and Safety Ward Programme with the focus to strengthen the safety and security and law enforcement capacity of municipalities in the Western Cape. The programme will provide 20 persons with training and development and work placement opportunities for a period 12 months. Participants will receive a monthly stipend of R 2300.

Unemployed persons that meet the following criteria are hereby invited to apply to participate in the Peace and Safety Warden Programme.

- Applicants must reside within the borders of the Prince Albert Municipal Area
- Unemployed Youth between the age of 18 – 25
- Grade 12 / Matric Certificate
- No Criminal Record

Successful applicants must be available to attend a 2 week compulsory training session during November 2019. It will also be required from successful applicants to do a SAPS clearance to verify criminal record status. Successful applicants will also sign a memorandum of agreement with the Department of Community Safety that will be binding for the duration of the programme.

Interested applicants who meet the abovementioned criteria should apply using the prescribed application form obtainable from the nearest municipal office (during normal office hours). Only correct and fully completed application forms will be considered. Completed applications must be at the nearest municipal office.

- A comprehensive Curriculum Vitae
- Proof of qualification/latest examination results
- Certified copy of Identity Document (not older than 3 months)
