



PUBLIC NOTICE

PRINCE ALBERT MUNICIPALITY NAMING AND NUMBERING POLICY

Notice is hereby given in terms of Section 21 of the Municipal Systems Act, 2000 (Act 32 of 2000), that the Prince Albert Municipality has finalized the Street Naming and Numbering Policy. The development of the mention policy would also result in re-numbering of properties in area affected by improper numbering.

The purpose of the policy is to:

- **Provide clear guidelines** for the consistent naming and numbering of streets within the municipal area.
- **Ensure compliance** with applicable legislation and municipal by-laws.
- **Promote accessibility** for emergency services, postal delivery, and public administration.

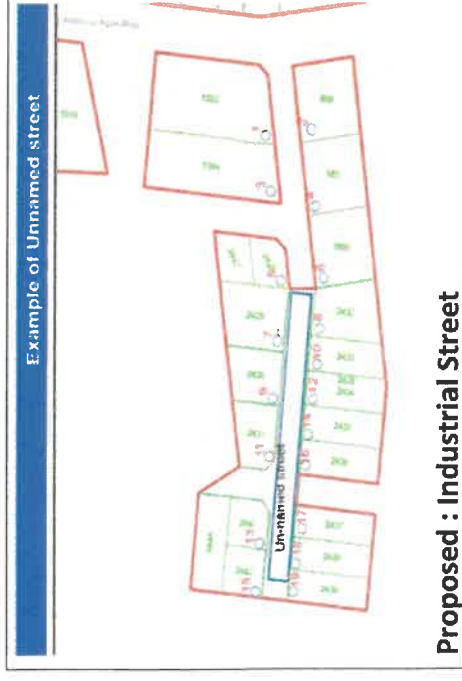
Community members are invited to submit written comments or representations focusing on the following:

- **Input on the Content of the draft policy** (Street naming and numbering policy)
- **Choose preferred name** on the street with more than 1 name
- **Naming of unnamed streets**
- **Suggestion on new street names** for streets which have same name, different spelling, or which sound same
- **Choose 1 name** for continued street with different names

In the interest of transparency and public participation, members of the public, interested parties, community organisations, and stakeholders are hereby invited to submit written comments, objections, or representations regarding the proposal.
